Hunslet Warriors RFC



Up in our Leeds territory, we've modernised Hunslet Warriors Rugby Club, in partnership with the Rugby League World Cup.

They've created a new female-only shower and changing room from a disused men's bathroom, a new physio room, and a new match day kitchen to help the club become more financially sustainable, as well as redecorating the changing rooms and entrance of the club to give it a more modern look. And what a team effort it's been - 60 young people volunteered, in partnership with the National Careers Service, and a staggering 123 City & Guilds accreditations have been achieved! Our Lead Mentor on the project Saj was full of glowing feedback for our young volunteers who helped us complete this transformation.

TRADE MENTOR



Matloob Hashmi recently completed his first VIY project as a trade mentor with us at Hunslet Warriors Rugby Club. Matloob has now been a self-employed tradesperson for 14 years. "My first project was kind of an eye opener. On my first day I was really nervous because I had never worked with young people. After a few days I was thinking all of them years ago, I was like these kids, learning from someone to improve my skills. My favourite part was at the end of the day I would ask the kids if they enjoyed themselves and learnt anything that day, and with a big smile they would say "YES".



Young Londoners Fund



We delivered our second project day with our current cohorts of students on the Young Londoners Fund Programme at three Pupil Referral Units (PRU) in London. This month, 16 students helped build benches & planters for their outside areas, as well as refreshing their common room with brilliant paintwork.

We've also been working with the Royal Docks Learning & Activity Centre to improve and create different elements for the local community too. 11 young people took part in the project, some from a local PRU and more from the Amber Foundation; 7 gained their City & Guilds Entry Level 3 in Carpentry (the other 4 have already achieved this!)







Birmingham City Boxing Club

Home to current Olympic Champion Galal Yafai, this boxing club's had 11 young people from 2 local schools and 1 young boxer from the club itself complete works redecorating a disused room, funding a new floor and window for it to be utilised as a female exercise space. We also converted a shower into a new kitchenette to be used as a comfortable parent/guardian waiting room. We hope the young boxers and their Olympic heroes enjoy the space!

We've also kicked off our first ever project in youth American Football & Cheerleading at Kent Phoenix Club in Maidstone. As well as building new storage, redecorating & installing new toilets/kitchen, young people from Kent Youth Justice & West Kent College have also been joined by Peter Walsh from South London Partnerships & the Mayor's Construction Academy, who delivered employability and work readiness training to our learners. We're increasingly focusing on getting our young people ready for work in this way, alongside building their trade skills.
